### The result:

Cleantech Solar has completed four solar rooftop solar projects with a combined generating capacity of 2.4 MW under long-term agreements where Cleantech Solar has funded, built, and will operate and maintain the systems. The solar power plants, located in Lopburi, Korat and Petchaburi, will not only contribute to Cargill's global sustainability targets, they will also provide economic benefits in the form of cheaper-than-grid electricity.
